MAJOR INSTRUCTIONAL GOALS:

GOAL A:

Finalize a research proposal that is approved by a dissertation committee and the Wilmington University Human Subjects Review Committee (HSRC).

Learning Objectives: The student will:

- A-1 Develop a dissertation proposal and present it to the dissertation committee for approval.
- A-2 Submit the committee approved research proposal to HSRC and secure approval to conduct the research.
- A-3 With committee approval, establish milestone dates (form attached).

GOAL B:

Collect and analyze data in accordance to the HSRC approved research proposal.

Learning Objectives: The student will:

- B-1 Implement the HSRC approved data collection plan.
- B-2 Analyze collected data using appropriate data analysis tools and strategies.
- B-3 Draw appropriate conclusions and recommendations based on the analysis of the data.

GOAL C:

Complete the dissertation document and present the findings in an oral defense.

- C-1 Complete the final dissertation document and submit to the committee for approval.
- C-2 Prepare and present an oral defense of the dissertation research.
